<b>DATE</b>	Sunday, 22 October 2017
<b>VENUE</b>	Royal Grammar School, Little London, Worcester, WR1 1PU
<b>ROUND</b>	Double Worcester (GNAS Record Status) Single Worcester (GNAS Record Status) NB: archers who shoot the “Double” may only claim ‘Single’ records based on their first round score.
<b>5-SPOT FACES (Not U.K.R.S.)</b>	‘5-Spot’ Worcester faces are available on some bosses. Scores shot on this face will be eligible for the tournament, but may be ineligible for awards that require an officially sanctioned face – e.g. UK Records. Scoring will be 4&5 only, ‘X’s recorded but ignored.
<b>REGISTRATION SIGHTERS</b>	From 0930 Session ‘A’ 1030, ‘B’ 1330 (approx). N.B. Equipment may be inspected by the judges prior to ‘sighters’, and competitors <i>must</i> be ready <i>at least</i> 15 mins. ahead of these times.
<b>ENTRIES</b>	Entries will only be accepted on receipt of payment. Places will be allocated on a first-come first served basis.
<b>FEES</b>	Cheques payable to:- <i>"DAS Limited"</i> Entries with post dated cheques will be treated as received on the date of the cheque (see above). Seniors £9 / Juniors £7(per session)

## **SCORES & RECORDS**

Archers are responsible for their own scores, and the accuracy of the score sheet submitted at the end of the competition. Archers claiming records Or other awards (such as Roses) must see the Organiser in person before the close of proceedings.

Arithmetic errors may be corrected by the Tournament Organiser in accordance with Rule 306(d)

## **AWARDS**

Trophies and/or medals will be awarded for the Double Round in the divisions of Recurve, Compound & Longbow: archer categories will be Senior Lady, Senior Gent, Junior Lady & Junior Gent. Medals may be awarded to archers shooting the above categories in the single round if numbers warrant.

Junior archers will be treated as shooting for junior awards only, unless the senior entry fee has been paid and it is clearly stated on the entry form (or at registration) that the archer wishes to shoot for senior awards.

The number of awards will depend on the number of entries in each category.

## **TEAM AWARDS**

There are two Team Trophies: Compound & Recurve. Teams are made up of three archers from one club, and must include a lady or a junior. Scores from the Double Round are expected – single round scores are acceptable with the obvious penalty.

## **DRESS**

GNAS dress regulations will apply (rule 307)

## **DRUG TESTING**

Competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a failure.

## **DISABLED & V.I ARCHERS.**

We are happy to accept entries from disabled & V.I. archers, and will do our best to accommodate any special requirements (subject to meeting the requirements of safety & Record Status). Please contact the Tournament Organiser in advance to discuss any requirements you have.

## **ACCESIBILITY**

There is a single step at the entrance to the hall. With this minor exception the venue is accessible to

disabled competitors. If you require assistance please ask.

#### **Directions to the venue from the South East, South & West.**

1. **From the M5 Junction 7**, take the A44 heading for Worcester.
2. **From Malvern**, cross the Severn Bridge into Worcester.
3. Once into Worcester follow the signs for A449 Kidderminster.
4. The road will lead you round the East bank of the River Sever, past the Race Course, the Police Station & Magistrates Court to a 'T' junction by the County Court, where you must turn left.
5. After ½ mile turn right into Little London. The carpark is immediately on your lefthand side, or you can park in front of the ATS Tyre depot.

#### **Directions to the venue from the North East & North.**

1. **From the M5 Junction 6**, take the A449 heading for Worcester.
2. **From Droitwich** take the A38 heading for Worcester.
3. The A449 & A38 merge at Gheluvelt Park.
4. After ½ mile turn left into Little London, then as above.
