JLU12	= Metric V	(30/20/15/10)

Consideration will be given to shooting single details of 3 archers.

Gents WA1440 (90/70/50/30)

Ladies WA1440 (70/60/50/30)

Gents Cadet (70/60/50/30)

Ladies Cadet (60/50/40/30)

Squad & Team makeup:

Each county can nominate a squad of up to 12 archers. The final team to be assembled from the made scores, the exact makeup to be decided by negotiation between the team managers. Probably something like 5 Recurves + 1 Compound. The only stipulation is that one member from each team must shoot the gender-appropriate U18 round.

Eligibility:

Each County Team Manager is free to set eligibility criteria, subject to all archers competing being, on the day of the tournament,

- Current GNAS members
- Under 18 years of age
- Primary affiliation to the county they are representing
- Sufficiently experienced to understand tournament procedures, rules, timings & etiquette
- Understand & abide by The Rules, especially:
 - 307 (dress code = no jeans or camo)
 - 303(h) (no electronic comms forward of the waiting line)

Spare spaces:

Once the nominated squads have been allocated a target there will be some empty slots. These will be available for other nominated juniors to use. Applications for these spaces are to be made via your team manager or CCO. They will be allocated on a 'first-come, first-served' basis in late August.

Housekeeping:

Droitwich Archery Society have only recently moved to this ground, and facilities are limited. There is a toilet, and there will be tea/coffee making facilities etc.

Safeguarding:

Under CWAA rules the event will be run under the auspices of the host club's Child Welfare Officer. The Droitwich CWO is contactable on cwo@droitwicharchery.co.uk. All juniors must be accompanied at all times by an appropriate adult.
