- Eligibility:** Shoot is open to junior AGB members (under 18 on the day of the shoot). Up to 20<sup>th</sup> December 2017 priority will be given to archers affiliated through Worcestershire. After this date applications from all counties will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Non Worcestershire archers are welcome to apply early – they will be placed on a waiting list and allocated to spare places on 21<sup>st</sup> December.
