<b>Round</b>	UKRS WA18m. Triple Spot Vertical faces will be used on all bosses. Four archers per boss in two details of two timed ends of 3 arrows in 2 minutes. Two practice ends will be shot at the start of each WA18m round. The hall is well lit. Straw bosses on H Frames.
