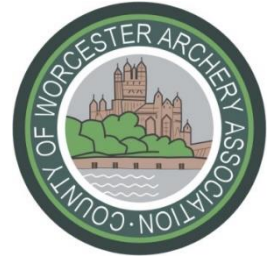


Results for the Malvern Archers



16th Open Nationals

Incorporating the CWAA Novice Championship



July 24th 2022

Venue: Manor Park Sport club Malvern Worcestershire.

Well I won't labour over the reason that it has been a fully 3 years since we last staged this event, we've all heard quite enough of that and I'm sure are all delighted for normality to be returning.

While our original intention was to have run the event in two sessions, entries were just not sufficient to justify it and it simply would not have been the kind of shoot we wanted if the field was not full. This proved to be a good decision because we could not have wanted for a nicer atmosphere with many Archers meeting up for the first time in months, if not years, and a number of family groups enjoying the day supporting those shooting.

The barbeque and kettle were on to ensure everyone was well fuelled for the tournament and our normally sheltered field decided the Archers needed a little bit more of a challenge with a changeable and gusty wind swirling around the field for much of the day.



Despite these windy conditions two young lady recurve Archers let us know that they were here to put down some serious scores right from the outset, with Hannah posting 104 (National) and Abigail 102 (S-J National) for their first dozens which bettered Dave and Steve's 100 on the Gents Compound. Hannah went on to score 50 or above on every end at 60 yards for a dominant win in our Lady Recurve category with a score of 600 and Abigail following up a 398 for her 30yards with an all Gold 20 yards for an incredible 614 for the best Junior Lady score.

The second end included the "Best Gold" competition, which Andrew judged in Heike's favour.

As the ends went by it was clear that what we lacked in depth of field we made up for in some close matches in a number of the categories. Ladies Compound was tied after 2 dozen and ended up decided by 6 point.

In the Ladies Novice, Saskia pegged back an early lead by Kelly and edged in front after 3 dozen arrows, with Kelly retaking the lead at the end of their first distance and holding her nerve with a more consistent 50 yards to take the ladies CWAA Novice title.

Ian and Richard, Evesham club mates shooting in the Gents novice Recurve category were evenly matched throughout, with Richard taking the lead after 3 dozen and holding on to the silver medal position by just 3 points at the end. Lee, despite giving away points for shooting the Long Nationals rather than the National was just too strong and ended the day as Gents Novice champion.



There was a similar story in Lady Longbow with Melissa getting ahead after 2 Dozen and holding her lead over Karen by 3 points, but a strong finish by Rachel who was shooting the Long National almost got her back into contention for the Trophy.

The leader boards on the Gents categories settled down early on with Dave Michael, Dave Martel and Mick Haines each winning from the front in Recurve, Compound and Long bow.

Dave Harris had a good lead after the 1st distance in the Gents Bare bow and I'm not sure if he'd had an equipment issue, bit of fatigue or fell victim to the cake in the break, but the door was open for Tony to get in front. Vic shooting the Long National finishing strong too.

Ethan shot an excellent 466 on the full National round for our Junior Gent title as Ben was using the home tournament for competition experience at a shorter distance. Ethan's score was good but not quite good enough, to deny Lily and her score of 503 the CWAA Junior Novice, which had also been enough for Silver in the Malvern Junior Lady recurve behind Abigale. Your day will come Bella.

And finally... the Team trophy, 3 Archers from the same club including a maximum of 1 Compound bow and a minimum of 1 lady or Junior. Well this year the ladies from Redhill were just too strong and left Malvern in second and Evesham in 3rd.
